Overview of School

Clarion School is the leading progressive American school in the UAE. Built off the Bank Street College of Education framework, Clarion offers a PK – Grade 4 education with an additional grade added every year. Staffed by class teachers who all have a Master's Degree in Education, the school seeks to redefine educational excellence in the region. The current cohort of the school is 115 students expanding to 250 students next year. The school is staffed by American teachers (save for language specialists) and has a qualified Assistant Teacher in each class until Grade 5. The school caters to over 30 different nationalities with the largest population being North American.

Position Overview

The Early Years Head will lead and support the Early Years Team (Ages 3–5) in enabling a high quality learning environment that supports student outcomes in a developmentally appropriate way. The individual will not only be the pedagogical leader but ensure accountability in the early learning years. S/he must be a collaborative motivational leader. The ideal candidate must also be a strong practitioner of professional development. They should also be comfortable in working within a multicultural environment with a parent body that has high expectations. Strong understanding and use of data to inform teaching and learning is necessary. The candidate should be also be a skilled recruiter able to spot and develop quality teachers.
