Background

ISS is pleased to announce that it is partnering with Sias University in Zhengzhou, China to open the city's first international school for foreign students: Sias International School. ISS is conducting a global search for a Founding Head of School to lead the opening of the school.

The School

The new K-12 school will provide high quality English language Western education to foreign students, including boarding students. The school will emphasize rigorous education, innovation, creativity, and the comprehensive development of students. The school is scheduled to open in August, 2019.

The City

Zhengzhou is the capital of Henan Province and sits at the "center of heaven and earth" at the location of China's earliest civilization and the ancient and modern crossroads of China. Zhengzhou is an emerging international business center, enjoying significant new growth and development.

The Campus

ISS and Sias are partnering with the city to develop a modern, beautiful educational facility with state of the art technology, well designed and innovation-friendly learning spaces, and generously appointed activity venues. The school will have excellent venues for libraries, activities, team sports (including an indoor swimming pool), performing arts, and maker spaces. The school will also have opportunities to enhance its programs through access to and partnerships with the facilities, staff, and resources of Sias University, a leader in liberal arts education and innovation in China.

School Program of Learning

The school will offer a comprehensive, coeducational, college preparatory educational program, utilizing North American learning standards. High school students will participate in the Advanced Placement Program of



the College Board. Secondary students will have the option of boarding at the school.

The Position

Working closely with the ISS Senior Leadership Executive and the ISS Asia-Pacific Office, and utilizing the well-established ISS protocols for new school startups, the Founding Head of School will advise on the fitting out of classrooms and facilities, help develop the full scope of the school's programs, and administrative processes and structures. The Head of School will help design and execute marketing and admissions processes, recruit new staff, and carry out other related processes to prepare the school to open in August 2019.
