The School

Located in the province of Riau on Sumatra, Indonesia, Independent Schools Riau is a coeducational day school, accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC). ISR is sponsored by Chevron Pacific Indonesia (CPI). The school is primarily but not exclusively for the dependents of the expat oil company employees. ISR is located on the Rumbai Camp on the outskirts of the city of Pekanbaru, which has an



international airport. ISR is an International Schools Services (ISS) managed school; a Senior Leadership Executive guides and support the ISR administration. ISR serves a community of parents, composed almost exclusively of professionals in the petroleum industry. ISR has an international population of approximately 65 students.

CURRICULUM

ISR uses a rigorous North American standards-based curriculum, focusing on language arts, social studies, mathematics, science, physical education/health, art, life skills, library, technology as well as Indonesian culture class. Because of our excellent student-teacher ratio, even though there is no designated special-education program, we are able to offer individualized support and differentiation to our students.

ISR is committed to integrating the Expected Schoolwide Learning Results throughout the curriculum. All students at ISR are Global Stewards, Responsible Individuals, Expressive Communicators, Academic Achievers, Thinkers and Problem-Solvers, and Self-Directed Learners.



FACULTY

The School Board is committed to maintaining a faculty of top quality, professional teachers; as such the staff reflects a variety of backgrounds. The majority of our teachers possess either a U.S. or Canadian teaching certificate, 50% have a Master's degree. Of our 13 teachers, the nationalities of staff are American, Canadian, New Zealand, UK, and Indonesian.

FOCUS ON TECHNOLOGY

Our school technology infrastructure is advanced. The campus has a wireless network. One-toone technology devices are available to students from preschool to grade 8. All students in Middle School purchase a Mac laptop. Every classroom has a LCD projector, as well as access to a



scanner and printer. The school employs a technology facilitator to assist teachers in integrating technology into their curriculum.

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

ISR values professional development and the impact it can have on student learning. Teachers have the opportunity to access professional development funds to attend professional development workshops, seminars or credit courses that best meet the growth initiatives of the school and of the teacher.

Schools Riau. The Director will communicate on a professional level and maintain appropriate collegial relationships with all ISR stakeholders. The Director will work with the School Board, the ISR Foundation, the ISS Senior Leadership Executive, the Parent Teacher Organization and other stakeholder groups to continually enhance the quality of the school's programs and the life of its community.
