ISE is an authorized International Baccalaureate (IB) World School offering all three programs: Primary Years Program (PYP), Middle Years Program (MYP) and the Diploma Program (DP) for students aged 3-19. The school is accredited by

both the Council of International Schools (CIS) and the New England Association of Schools and Colleges (NEASC). The School has approximately 140 students from 30+ countries and has close relationships with the US Embassy and the European diplomatic community. We are a non-profit school celebrating over twenty years of excellence.

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ISE's students achieve great things. Many have gone on to study at the world's top universities, such as Yale and Oxford, and to work at global companies including Google and the European Bank. And it is particularly proud of its record in encouraging girls towards traditionally maledominated STEM (science, technology, engineering and mathematics) fields. The IB Diploma scores exceed international averages and the school has had a 100% pass rate in all but one student in the past decade.

School Director: Duties and Responsibilities

The Director shall be the chief executive officer of the Schools and shall be responsible to the Board. The Board shall determine his/her term of appointment and salary.

Subject to the policies established by the Board, the Director shall, among other matters:

- direct the everyday activities of the Schools;
- draft long-term plans for the Schools' curriculum, staffing and facilities;
- · appoint and dismiss staff members of the Schools;
- administer funds of the Association;
- enter into transactions on behalf of the Association and organise financial matters of the Association;
- set out the appropriate delegation of power and authority within the Schools;
- perform other duties prescribed for him/her in the Articles of Association, the Bylaws of the Schools and Estonian legislation.
