IPS is seeking an Upper Secondary Principal for their new upper secondary school that will open its doors in 2022. This key leadership role represents an exciting opportunity to lead the development of the school in accordance with the long-term strategic development plan and vision of the school. The Upper Secondary Principal will lead, inspire and offer guidance to the staff, students and parents, and ensure the smooth day-to-day operations of the school.



IPS was founded in 2011 as the International Playschool, and English-speaking preschool. Today, celebrating its ten-year anniversary, IPS is a group of schools offering international education for students ages 3-14, certified to follow the highest educational standards, with English as a language of instruction. It consists of IPS Nursery, IPS Playschool, IPS School and the IPS Music School. IPS is authorized by IBO (PYP Programme) and Cambridge

Assessment International (Primary and Lower Secondary Programmes).

School Overview

IPS is a family-friendly place that is safe, joyous and always open, not just for the children, but also for their parents.

With over 320 students and 50 teachers and other faculty members from more than 30 different nationalities, IPS is international and multicultural. The IPS' hometown, Wroclaw is called a meeting place, the junction of culture, the city of tolerance. IPS is a place of the same values.

English is used as the language of Curriculum and instruction. Modern campus, 3500 sqm, with additional sports facilities and playgrounds.

History



IPS was established in 2011 as a small international preschool, offering education in English to students aged 2-6. In 2012, IPS opened a location offering early childhood education. In order to offer our students a continuation into primary education at IPS, the IPS Primary & Lower Secondary School was opened, in 2014. In 2017, IPS opened a newly constructed campus of 2800 sqm, which was enriched with an additional 400 sqm, at the end of 2020. In 2015, IPS was accredited as an

IB World Candidate School in the PYP program and was successfully authorized in the beginning of 2018. In April 2016, the school was also authorized by Cambridge Assessment International in the Primary & Lower Secondary program. Currently IPS is the leading international school in Wroclaw.

Students

With more than 320 students from over 30 different nationalities, IPS is international and multicultural.

The learning at IPS also takes place outside the school walls during numerous field trips in which even the 3-year-olds participate.

Students starting in 1st grade go on overnight field trips twice a year. The trip in September is educational, while the one in June is more recreationally oriented. Everyone has a great time during both of them.



Curriculum

IPS offers IB PYP Programme and Cambridge Assessment International with Primary & Lower Secondary Programmes. In addition, the school is recognized by the Polish Ministry of Education and offers basics of the Polish National Curriculum.





Technology

IPS is a modern and well-equipped institution with smart boards in each classroom, laptops in mobile cabinets, tablets, kindles, headphones, etc. The IPS campus is fully covered with a private WiFi connection. IPS is a partner school with the Amazon Stem Academy.

The IPS Media Center provides a variety of books and a space arranged for quiet reading, computers for researching, tablets with headphones for reading e-books and listening to audiobooks and sound files, as well as space for working in groups.







Arts, Athletics & After School Activities

IPS runs an Arts program containing visual arts and music. IPS Music School is the only music school in Wroclaw that offers after school courses in English for piano, guitar, ukulele, violin, horn, trumpet, percussion, and voice.

IPS provides a range of sports activities including team sports such as basketball, volleyball, football, gymnastics, yoga, judo, swimming courses, kidfit, acrobatics, and dance in the basic curriculum, as well as afterschool clubs. In addition, the IPS after school clubs offer arts and design, chess, modern foreign languages and a science club.

Community

Parents are an important part of the IPS community. The school's PTA (Parent Teacher Association) brings people ready to act and help, full of ideas and initiatives.

The school life is full of events. The school's PTA and Student Council organize a Christmas Concert, Halloween dancing party, Cultural Diversity Day, School's Birthday Picnic, and special guests' meetings. At the end of the school year, there is a show with a concert.

Professional Development

IPS considers itself a community of life-long learners. Professional development support is provided through IB trainings, Cambridge subject trainings, and subject based workshops for English, Math, and Mindfulness. IPS "professional development weeks" take place at the end of August and January.

Academic Calendar

The school year for students starts September 1st and ends June 30th. It is comprised of two semesters with a Christmas break, Winter break and Easter break.



Elementary School Overview

Grades 1-5, IB PYP + Cambridge International (Primary)

The teaching in grades 1-5 is based on transdisciplinarity within so-called Units of Inquiry that integrate the knowledge and skills of Social Studies, Science, Mathematics, Language and Arts under one "big idea" — the central idea of each Unit. The curricula for Grades 1-5 are prepared in accordance with the standards, knowledge and competence of the national curricula of UK, USA and Poland. The teaching philosophy and

methods respond to the challenges of the 21st century education, considering closely the skills of synthesizing knowledge, selecting information, project work and collaboration within groups.

Middle School Overview

Grade 6-8 Cambridge International (Lower Secondary)

In Grades 6-8, IPS Primary School offers a subject-based education according to the Cambridge Primary and Secondary 1 international curriculum enriched by the elements of the Polish national curriculum for the grade level. IPS prepares students for the exams according to the British standards of the Cambridge University, so-called Lower Secondary Checkpoints as well as Polish state-required final exams at the end of primary education. IPS is especially devoted to support children's independence in their learning as well as conscious development of their own talents and skills.

High School Overview

Campus

IPS is located in a green neighborhood, in the heart of Wroclaw, which is 10 minutes away from the Old Town. The IPS campus of 3500 sqm opened in 2017, and consists of 22 classrooms, Arts Lab, Science Lab, two Gyms (full size gym and auxiliary gym), library, two cafeterias, two playgrounds. IPS is within walking distance to a football/athletic stadium, a swimming pool, a public library, and a quiet park with a playground.
