Established in 2012, The International School of Dongguan (ISD) is a coeducational day school located in Dongguan, the People's Republic of China (PRC). Dongguan is situated in southern Guangdong Province in between Shenzhen and Guangzhou.

The International School of Dongguan is a community that values student learning in an inclusive, creative, and caring environment. Our enthusiasm for learning, our

commitment to excellence, respect for diversity, and how deeply we care for each member of our community is evident in everything that we do at ISD.

ISD's mission is our school's compass; it guides us towards success and to a bright future. ISD is considered a young school, but our teaching faculty and staff have many years of experience. ISD offers many exciting programs to engage learners of every age and every interest – from academics to activities to athletics. Our school, like many other international schools around the world, is finding ways to encourage entrepreneurialship by using new technologies, utilizing world class programs such as the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme, looking at new ways of assessing, documenting, and reporting on learning.



ISD is a 12,000 square meter educational facility atop 30,000 square meters or almost 8.5 acres. The campus houses 50 classrooms within four floors. The 5th floor has an additional 6 classrooms and a conference room. ISD also boasts an 800 square meter indoor basketball court fully equipped with shower and changing rooms. The cafeteria can currently



seat 120 students but has the capacity to expand to seat 300 students. The campus has facilities for the arts, sciences, sports and technology. The art facilities house a modern Black Box Theatre, music rooms, art gallery, pottery kiln, screen and printing press, photography studio library and multimedia center. Our science labs are modern and our sports facilities are varied and state-of-the art, including the recent completion of an artificial turf sports field that accommodates two football pitches and a baseball diamond. During the 2016-

2017 school year, ISD became a full-fledged Baseball Sports Academy. ISD also has two outdoor basketball courts, two tennis courts, a full-size gymnasium and playgrounds. Our new Maker Space technology department classroom comes equipped with robotics and state of the art digital equipment such as a Laser Cutter and 3D printer.

We provide opportunities so that our students can be leaders in our community and ultimately in our interconnected world. SCOPE OF RESPONSIBILITY: The Principal directly supervises all staff assigned to grades 6-12.

REPORTING ACCOUNTABILITY: The Principal is directly responsible to the Head of School.
