Job Description: Test Preparation Specialist

Scope of Position: Dar Essalam American School (DAS) is an independent, Englishmedium, Pre-Kindergarten to Grade 12 international school in Rabat, Morocco, with the goal of providing a high-quality education to a diverse student body. The School has partnered with Lumo Education and International Schools Services (ISS) to develop an innovative curriculum that draws from the best of Finnish and American pedagogy to deliver a studentcentered, enriching, and challenging program that prepares students for lifelong success.

The Test Preparation Specialist plays a pivotal role in developing and implementing comprehensive preparation programs for standardized tests, specifically focusing on SAT, ACT, TOEFL, and IELTS. This position involves creating effective instructional materials, delivering engaging lessons, and providing personalized support to ensure students achieve their optimal test scores.

Key Responsibilities:
