Deprivatise & Scale

Deprivatise teacher practice via a range of internal and external communication channels

Scale innovations by codifying exemplar practice and sharing with the wider community

The first iteration of this model (developed many years ago now) was based off work with @dianabeabout, @mmruthai and @mcelroy23 at #SISrocks. The intent was to repeatedly socialise the artefact through presentations, online, and in print to help increase teacher understanding and engagement with the LICS. It also recognised that identifying, documenting and showcasing exemplar practice was critical to scaling innovation across the school. It's a time consuming and valuable process that needs to be called out.
