## ACCREDITATION AND ACADEMIC PROGRAMS

The Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) has granted NCPA full accreditation status. The curriculum is aligned to U.S. standards including the Common Core State Standards, and offers Advanced Placement courses in the High School. NCPA uses Stanford University's Six Principles of English Language Learning as the foundational framework of its immersion model. A.P. courses are open to all students and most take 7 A.P. courses over four years.



## FACULTY

All NCPA faculty are native-level English speakers, with the exception of the Chinese language teachers. All of the content-area faculty hold North American diplomas and licensure. Seventy five percent of our faculty hold advanced degrees, including 3 with doctorates.

## CAMPUS AND FACILITIES

With a modern, purpose-built 31-acre campus, NCPA offers its students a broad range of quality facilities to further their growth. This includes a state-of-the-art Innovation Hub (combining makerspace, design studio, and wood shop), Olympic-sized swimming pool, indoor gym and five outdoor courts, a flexible learning space known as the e-Learning Center, and an expansive green quad in the middle of campus.

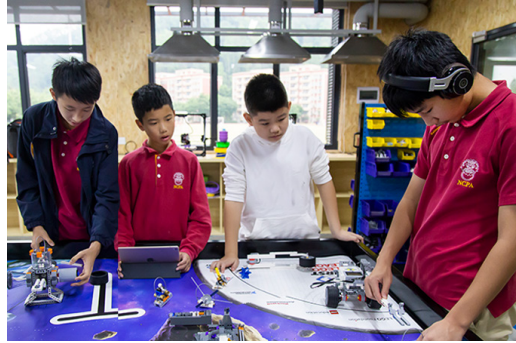

## A HOLISTIC EDUCATION AT NCPA

With over 80 extracurricular options, Nansha College Preparatory Academy (NCPA) students are involved in activities that cultivate lifelong habits in physical health, personal and interpersonal skills, and connectedness to faculty and peers. Programs and opportunities include:

- **Range of Studies:** NCPA's curriculum includes 27 elective courses offered across all departments.
- **Advising:** Grade 7-10 students meet every other day in small groups with their faculty advisors; juniors and seniors are scheduled into semester-long seminar classes with their counselors.
