In addition to providing a strong academic foundation for students, Riffa Views International School (RVIS) also provides a holistic, well-rounded learning experience in the context of a safe, supportive environment. Students at RVIS have the opportunity to explore the world outside of academia and develop skills through a wide-range of specialist classes and co-curricular activities, including:

- **Arts:** The performing arts are a vital part of all students' education. Across grades, students have the opportunity to grow skills in art, theatre, music, and more.
- **Technology:** RVIS is wired with fiber-optic cable as well as a wireless network throughout the campus. Interactive Smart Boards and LCD projectors are standard equipment in all RVIS classrooms. Thin client laptops are available for every student in every academic classroom.
- **RVIS Library:** The RVIS library is designed to act as a bridge between the elementary and secondary programs. Its bright, spacious windows and natural light have become a focal point of the school.
- **Athletic Facilities:** RVIS students have access to the Riffa Views Colin Montgomerie PGA level championship golf course, 6 outdoor tennis courts, a 25-meter competition swimming pool, training pool, purpose built gymnasium, a full sized FIFA-standard soccer field, and mini basketball court.
